NDSBA SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM

NDSBA recognizes board members for their professional development and service on two levels: *Veteran Board Member* and *Master Board Member*. A point system has been adopted whereby each opportunity carries a specific value. When a board member has earned 100 points, a certificate will be awarded designating the individual as a *Veteran Board Member*. When 200 points are earned, the designation is *Master Board Member* and a certificate and lapel pin will be awarded. Recipients will be recognized at the NDSBA Annual Convention.

NOTE: Board members who participate in national meetings will earn either certificate "with distinction."
