Governor's Budget Proposal

- 4/3 Per pupil increase 70% of new monies to teacher salaries
- Move to on-time funding immediately
- Bring all transition maximum districts onto the formula ASAP
- BND loans for CTE Academy projects
- \$250 million to PERS, support for closing the DB plan in favor of DC
